In Confluence, content is organised into spaces. **Each space has it's own access control settings.** There are two types of space:

* **_Global_** spaces are areas on your site into which you can group content items (pages, attachments, news, etc) based on any subject or topic of your choice. For example, you may want separate areas on your site for each team or project within your organisation. In Confluence, you can set up a different space for each team or project. You can build content for each of these spaces individually, decide who its users are, and even archive mail separately within each. ~~For example, you may want separate areas on your site for each team or project within your organisation.~~
