You should create personal, team or project Calendar to plan specific activities and share it with your colleagues.

To plan issue in just click in the specific days or hours or drag existing issue to there. Also, Calendar tracks estimate time and fixes it within JIRA.

It is simple to filter and colorize issues on the Calendar, because you can add your own quick filters on it. So, it means you can filter a view just a specific type of issues or specific group of assignees.

You can use stored favorites or JQL-filters to create a quick calendar filter and define what do you want - hide or colorize issues on Calendar.

Day, Week, Month

You could plan issues with the next views: day, week, month.

Each of these view has a unique properties. For example, you can plan long time issues on the Month View, and short time issues on the detailed Day View.

A Week View has a special area, where are placed unplanned issues. So, you could just drag them to the main Calendar area to plan.

Also you can define a specific work time for each Calendar Views.
